Latest updates

It has been another short half term but packed with lots of exciting learning opportunities taking place.

A large group of our Y5&6 pupils took part in the Young Voices concert at Sheffield Arena—this was an amazing experience for everyone involved. The children had a great time on World Book Day getting dressed up and enjoying reading activities. Our Year 6 pupils ran some pop up story sessions at breaktime where younger pupils came to listen. Eight of our Year 6 pupils also took part in the Kirklees World Book Day Quiz at the Town Hall. They had been reading a set of books since September which the quiz was based around. The quiz also involved pupils from Year 7 as well. We were delighted that one of our teams came 1st overall in the event. This was a fantastic achievement and the first time that we have won this event as a school. Well done to the team.

Each class have completed some extra Art sessions this half term to produce work based around colour mixing that will be displayed during our Arts Festival that takes place in late June.

Lots of classes also carried out some extra Science sessions to celebrate British Science week. The children had great fun carrying out various practical experiments.

Frog Class (Y4) have been on their residential visit to Cliffe House. The children were a pleasure to take and enjoyed 3 days of adventurous activities.

Year 5 and Year 1 have visited Almondbury and Lepton Methodist churches as part of their RE curriculum and learnt about Easter. Our Assembly Themes have covered Being Positive, Being Grateful, Being Health (Body & Mind), Being Inquisitive (World Book Day and Science Week), Being Aware (Ramadan).

We have also started a new programme of learning for Personal, Social & Emotional development called My Happy Mind. This is a whole school approach where the children are learning about how their brain works and how to have a positive mindset as well as how to recognize and regulate emotions. There are supporting resources for parents to access that run alongside this programme which we will be sharing with you after the holidays.

Alongside the class based activities there have also been two football tournaments run by Sam Mir (SM Sports) for Year 6. Both the boys and the girls events were well attended and the children were excellent sporting representatives.

Our team of runners who qualified for the West Yorkshire Cross Country finals went to Leeds earlier this half term. All of the runners were fantastic sporting representatives and had done amazingly well to reach a final of that level. However, a special mention must go to our Y4 Boys' Team who came 3rd overall out of the whole of West Yorkshire.

Our Easter Raffle took place yesterday—there were a total of 112 prizes which included many chocolate eggs of various sizes as well as some cuddly toys and items for Easter Crafts. All pupils had a ticket in the draw. Thank you for your support buying tickets which has helped towards PTA fundraising.

Our non-uniform and KS2 stalls day today has raised £1152.57 for Comic Relief—what a fabulous amount!
